University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations (Cambridge ESOL) provides the world's leading range of qualifications for learners and teachers of English for speakers of Other Languages (ESOL), taken by almost 4 million people in 135 countries every year. Cambridge ESOL has authorised examination centres all over the world, including 44 in Russia.

Centres sign an Authorised Centre Agreement, which is a contract with Cambridge ESOL regulating the carrying out of the exams they are approved to deliver. RU037 Moscow Institute of Foreign Languages (MIFL) has been one such centre since 2008 and it was the first Russian higher education establishment to become an authorised Cambridge ESOL centre.

Since 2008 Amet Volodarskiy has ensured that preparation for Cambridge ESOL exams is part of the MIFL curriculum and that MIFL administers Cambridge ESOL examinations as an integral part of students' courses and certification. This inclusion is unique in the context of Russian higher education establishments.
